



Vivitrol Treatment: How It Works

EPIC Behavioral Healthcare is now offering medically assisted treatment through Vivitrol— a long-acting formula that's paired with counseling to prevent the relapse of opioid dependence following an opioid detox.

HOW IT WORKS:

- Patient is referred for consult for the consideration of Vivitrol treatment.
- EPIC staff meet privately with the patient to assess motivation for recovery and eligibility for treatment.
- Care Coordinator will arrange for lab work to be completed. Doctor reviews lab and assessment results for approval.
- If approved patient comes for consents, is given the Naloxone Challenge and pregnancy test before the injection.

Some criteria includes:

- Patient must be detoxed from Opiates (7-15 days).
- Patient must not be pregnant.
- All patients receiving Vivitrol must agree to completing at least one month of counseling following their first shot.

We recognize that addiction is both physical and psychological, and therefore want to be able to monitor the progress of each patient during their treatments.
