Our Care Coordination Services

- 1. Assess your needs and goals
- 2. Create a proactive care plan
- 3. Communicate and share knowledge of providers
- 4. Linkage to community resources
- 5. Help with transitions of care
- 6. Monitor progress and follow-up, including responding to changes in your needs

Linkages of Referrals May Include:

- Primary health care (Insurance, medical or dental services)
- Behavioral health care (Individual and group counseling, medication management)
- Housing
- Basic needs (Food, clothing, transportation or communication)
- Employment or education programs
- Benefits (Food stamps, SSI, SSA or Veteran's benefits)
- Criminal justice navigation
