### Services Available:

- Outreach, screening, and assessment of need for substance use and mental health services
- Detoxification in an inpatient setting (OB provider clearance required)
- Outpatient and inpatient substance use and mental health treatment
- Trauma services, including assessment and interventions for emotional, sexual, and physical abuse
- Medication Assisted Recovery (MAR): Licensed medical provider evaluation for medications to assist recovery during and immediately following pregnancy
- Assistance with finding prenatal care and coordination between specialties
- Assist with resources to access medical and dental services
- Care coordination, peer support, and counseling services
- Resources for safe housing for women and their children
- Assistance in searching for employment
